Guidelines for enjoying your tour: Please respect the private property of our barn quilt owners. Unless it's a public place, such as Thacher Nature Center, please remain in your vehicle. At 634 Pleasant Valley Road, you may drive down the driveway and turn around in the circle.

- Drive carefully. There may be farm machinery, farm animals, or woodland creatures on the road. Use extra caution on our hills in wintertime.
- Park carefully. Many roads have minimal or no shoulder, so pull over as far as you can and put on your hazard lights if you wish to stop and take photos.
- All barn quilts are visible from public roads. If a road is marked "DEAD END," drive along it until you come to the barn quilt, then turn around there.
- Respect our "working farms." Please do not pet the animals and watch out for electric fences and poison ivy.

The beautiful Helderberg Hilltowns are rural and have limited services, so be sure you have gas in your car and cash in your pocket!
